Subject: Procurement of Aggregated Power of 2500 MW for three years (covered under medium term) through PFC Consulting Limited as Nodal Agency – Pilot Scheme.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that a Pilot Scheme is being introduced to facilitate procurement of aggregated power of 2500 MW for 3 (three) years (covered under medium term) from the generating companies having coal based Power Plants which are already commissioned without having a power purchase agreement for the quantum of power the Bidder is willing to bid. The proposed scheme envisages Procurement of Power through competitive bidding process to be conducted by PFC Consulting Limited, as Nodal Agency and facilitated by an Aggregator. The Aggregator will sign an Agreement for Procurement of Power with the Successful Bidder(s) and back to back Power Supply Agreement with the Distribution Licensee(s).

2. In order to introduce the above mentioned Pilot Scheme for procurement of aggregated power of 2500 MW for three years under medium term, the bidding documents comprising of (i) Standard Bidding Document comprising both the Model Pilot Request for Qualification (the "MPRFQ") and the Model Pilot Request for Proposal (the "MPRFP"); (ii) Model Pilot Agreement for Procurement of Power (the "MPAPP"); (iii) Model Pilot Power Supply Agreement (the "MPPSA") (collectively, the "Model Pilot Bidding Documents") are being issued herewith to be adopted by the Nodal Agency for procurement of power from the power

producers through a process of open and transparent competitive bidding through an electronic platform (DEEP e-Bidding Portal). The Guidelines in this regard are being issued separately.
